## SPRTNG SOUNDS

A phoneme segmentation game


## EXAMPLE three sounds



For the word dog, students should point to:
$l^{\text {st }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{d} /$ sound
$2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{o} /$ sound
$3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{g} /$ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.

## EXAMPLE four sounds



For the word sloth, students should point to:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \mathrm{lst}^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{dot} / \mathrm{s} / \text { sound } \\
& 2^{\text {nd }} \text { dot: } / / / \text { sound } \\
& 3^{\text {rd }} \text { dot: } / 0 / \text { sound } \\
& 4^{\text {th }} \text { dot: } / \text { th/ sound }
\end{aligned}
$$

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.
