# SCHOOL SOUNDS 

The purpose of this activity is to provide practice segmenting words with three and four phonemes.

## EXAMPLE three sounds



For the word nod, students should point to:

> std dot: $/ \mathrm{n} /$ sound
> $2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{o} /$ sound $3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{d} /$ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.

## EXAMPLE four sounds



For the word toast, students should point to:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \text { lst dot: /t/ sound } \\
& 2^{\text {nd }} \text { dot: /oa/ sound } \\
& 3^{\text {rd }} \text { dot: /s/ sound } \\
& 4^{\text {th }} \text { dot: } / \mathrm{t} / \text { sound }
\end{aligned}
$$

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.
