


## SOARING SOUNDS

The purpose of this activity is to provide practice segmenting words with three and four phonemes.

## EXAMPLE three sounds




For the word *ham*, students should point to:

l<sup>st</sup> dot: /h/ sound 2<sup>nd</sup> dot: /a/ sound 3<sup>rd</sup> dot: /m/ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.

## EXAMPLE four sounds



For the word *sleep*, students should point to: I<sup>st</sup> dot: /s/ sound 2<sup>nd</sup> dot: /l/ sound 3<sup>rd</sup> dot: /ee/ sound 4<sup>th</sup> dot: /p/ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.
