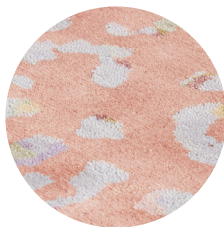

Spreckels, named after the famous surfer Bunker Spreckels is crafted using 90% silk and 10% wool, finished with raw cotton fringing. Hand cut wool freckles add character to the monochromatic texture. The naturally darker silk used to weave the Spreckels is designed to disguise any marking.
