




Please note, the flexible cable attached to this luminaire cannot be replaced; if the cable is damaged, recycle the luminaire and seek a replacement.












### STEP 1


Insert the bulb into the lampholder and rotate clockwise until secure. Take care not to tighten too much to avoid breakage.

\*Note, the lampholder is deliberately separated from the metal lamp base.






Insert the EU plug into the UK Adapter, making sure it clicks-in and does not come loose.



### STEP 4

Insert the lamp plug into your chosen wall socket, making sure the power is switched off.



### STEP 5

Switch the power on and rotate the dial on your dimmer until the bulb lights up. Adjust the dimmer for your desired light output.
