



HAND-TUFTED

The hand-tufted technique is a versatile method of rug making. Our skilled artisans use a tufting gun to punch yarn into a textile cloth backing, creating a plush pile surface. We often vary the pile in cut or looped, and its height often varies across the design to create depth and texture. Patterns are expressed through free-form compositions, intricate detailing, and hand-drawn effects, achieved by playing with colours, combining different yarns, and embossing the surfaces. Finally, the surface is carefully sheared with scissors to refine the finish and enhance the design details.

• Key characteristics

Pile surface and cotton cloth backside
Typically crafted in wool
Fast production method: 4 days for tufting size 6'6" x 9'8"
