



HAND-WOVEN

The hand-woven technique is one of the oldest methods of rug making. In flat weaving, the yarn runs across the full width of the rug, interlaced with warp threads to form graphic patterns and surface effects. Designs are created through colour variation, weave structure, and the combination of different yarn types, ranging from bold geometrics to subtle tonal compositions.

• Key characteristics

Flatwoven and thinner than other rug types

Often reversible

Warp setup: 15 days

Weaving time: 3 days for size 6'6" x 9'8"

Design possibilities

Graphic and geometric patterns Subtle tonal and minimal designs
