

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Faucet

Proper care and maintenance of faucet/faucets are essential for ensuring their longevity and optimal performance. Below are some key practices and tips for maintaining your faucet/faucets:

- **Faucets are a breeding ground for mold, mildew, and lime buildup, and should be cleaned regularly.**
- **Use a mild limescale/rust cleaner to remove buildup from your faucet.**
- **Wipe the faucet with a damp cloth and dry completely with a soft cloth to avoid water spots. Spray the cloth instead of the faucet to preserve the finish.**
- **To prevent hardwater buildup on the faucet, soak the head in a 50/50 mix of tap water and distilled white vinegar or apple cider vinegar. Allow the faucet head to soak for 30 minutes in the mixture.**



AVOID

- **Do not use** strong abrasive cleaners, metal scrub pads, steel wool or the rough side of the sponge. These will scratch and dull the surface of the faucet.
- **Do not use** cleaners beyond soap, acetic or citric acid and water.
- **Do not use** soap with beads or sparkles as they may clog the pump.
- **Do not soak** or submerge the pump.
