PARK SLOPE

Inspired by familiar motifs of the American Arts and Crafts movement, the Park Slope Collection evolves the style with a softer, lighter touch. Rows of iconic spindles curve gently to create an enveloping effect. Reverse-tapered legs ground each piece, while an interplay of modern details and negative space adds lightness.

As it marries the traditional and the modern, Park Slope upholds Stickley's commitment to meticulous craftsmanship, with authentic, solid-wood construction and hand-applied finishes that reveal the wood's innate beauty.

COMFORT WITH EVERY CURVE

The Park Slope Bed shows how a mid-century modern influence lightens the Arts and Crafts style. Its wraparound headboard—a combination of reverse-tapered columns, square spindles, and a sculptural cap rail—embraces the occupant, and a raised cantilever base adds airy space all around.

SOLID QUARTERSAWN WHITE OAK

Quartersawn American white oak produces boards of great strength, less likely to crack, check, or warp than flat-sawn timber and ideal for crafting furniture that will last for generations. Quartersawing also reveals the ray flake, a highly prized tiger-stripe pattern running across the grain that makes each piece of furniture unique.

CRAFTED FOR BEAUTY

Every element of the Park Slope bedroom is a testament to the quality of American craftsmanship. Alongside the meticulously constructed bed, the collection's case pieces are every bit as sculptural, though in a quieter way; on these uninterrupted surfaces, the wood's stunning grain becomes the focus. Park Slope is available in black cherry and quartersawn white oak, each creating a distinctive and desirable look beneath one of Stickley's unique hand-rubbed finishes.

ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY

At Stickley, we have long been committed to our environment and to sustainable growth. To diminish our ecological footprint, we hand-sort each piece of wood, careful to minimize waste. Unused trim blocks and sawdust are repurposed as fuel that employees may use to heat their homes in winter; our Manlius factory is entirely heated using the sawdust produced by our workshop.

The Park Slope trestle table has a distinctly modern feel. At its base, spindles are arranged in two broad bows to provide a fresh perspective from every direction. The shape is echoed in the subtle, perfect curves that form the Park Slope shelter chairs.

HAND-RUBBED FINISHES

Stickley finishes are hand-applied in multiple layers, achieving a clarity seldom seen in furniture today. Every detail of the wood grain is not merely visible but beautifully enhanced. The final step is a careful hand-rubbing process that creates the desired luster. Made with no dipping and no conveyor belts, a Stickley finish is uniquely “hands-on.”

It's rare to consider how furniture plays with light, yet in a sense, light is a feature built into the Park Slope Collection. In every room, spindles and center splats filter light, casting beams and shadows that shift throughout the day. A piece that lends the room a certain look in the morning may create an entirely new mood as the sun sets.



TIMELESS SEATING

In Park Slope's loveseats, sofas, and accent chairs, plush cushions live within frames of tall spindles that curve into a sheltering embrace. Sculptural armrests, supported by their own gentle radial curves, sit at the perfect height to flatter the sitter. The result is seating that is both visually striking and deeply comfortable.
