



BUNNY LOVEY

Skill Level: **EASY**

Pattern: **M25255 FB**



LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA® BUNNY LOVEY

EASY

SIZE

About 13 1/2 in. (34.5 cm) tall, not including bunny ears

MATERIALS

Lion BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA® (Art. #215)
#101 Pink 2 balls
Lion BRAND® stitch markers
Lion BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
Fiberfill stuffing
Black embroidery floss
Dark pink embroidery floss

GAUGE

16 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

sc3tog (sc 3 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

NOTES

1. Lovey is worked from the head downwards.
2. Ears are worked separately and sewn to top of head.
3. Head is worked in continuous rnds (spiral). Do not join last st of rnds to first st with a slip st and do not turn at beginning of rnds.
4. Blanket is worked in rows from bottom of head downwards.
5. Eyes and nose are embroidered onto face following Diagram.

LOVEY

Head

Ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 3: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 7-13: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 14: * Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 15: * Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 16: * Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Do not fasten off.

Blanket

Row 1: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sts; leave rem 9 sts unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to last 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 2 sts – 11 sc.

Rows 3-23: Rep Row 2 until there are 53 sc in the last row you work.

Make Paws

Row 24: Ch 12 for first paw, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 10 ch, sc in each st across – 64 sc.

Row 25: Ch 12 for 2nd paw, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 10 ch, sc in each st across – 75 sc.

Rows 26-30: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 31: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to last 11 sts; leave last 11 sts unworked – 64 sc.

Row 32: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to last 11 sts; leave last 11 sts unworked – 53 sc.

Row 33: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 4 sts, sc2tog, sc in last 2 sts – 51 sc.

Rep Row 33 until there are 7 sc in the last row you work.

Next row: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last st – 5 sts.

Next row: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, [sc2tog] twice – 3 sts.

Next row: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog – 1 st.
Fasten off.

EARS (make 2)

Ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) twice – 8 sts.

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) twice – 10 sts.

Rnd 4: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) twice – 12 sts.

Rnd 5: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts) twice – 14 sts.

Rnd 6: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts) twice – 16 sts.

Rnds 7-14: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 15: (Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts) twice – 14 sts.

Rnds 16-19: Sc in each st around.

Do not stuff Ear.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Use tail to sew lower edges together. Do not trim tail, it can be used later to sew Ear to head.

FINISHING

Stuff head and sew lower opening closed. Sew Ears to top of head. Be certain to sew Ears very securely.

With black embroidery floss, embroider straight st eyes on face, following diagram.

With dark pink embroidery floss, embroider straight st nose and mouth, following diagram.

Tie a knot in each paw.

Weave in ends.
