## Introduction

Making your own jewellery is so much fun. This kit shows you how to make fabulous necklaces and bracelets with pretty beads and Pet Charms.

There are enough materials in this kit to make up to 10 Pet Charm Jewellery designs, which you'll be proud to wear or give as gifts to friends and family.

- 40 x Bicone Beads (Blue, Pink)
- 120 x Round Beads (Pink, White, Blue, Purple)
- 30 x Faceted Beads (Purple, Yellow)
- 4 x Heart Frame Beads
- 3 x Key Rings (to attach charms)
- 10 x Clasp Beads
- 5 x Clasps
- 5m Stretch Cord
- Colour Instruction Manual

### Using the Heart Bead frames (for a bracelet)

2. Thread beads halfway along the cord depending on the beads you choose, you will roughly need 10 beads for the first side. Then thread through one side of the heart frame.

1. Cut 25cm length of stretch cord or smaller, depending on the size of your wrist. Always ask an adult to help when using scissors.

3. Pick out a pet charm and thread this onto the cord too.

**4.** Thread the cord through the next hole of the heart and repeat the same pattern of beads on the second half of the bracelet.

5. When you are happy with the length, knot both cord ends together 3 to 4 times pulling the cord very tight each time. Trim off the ends.





To create a necklace, repeat the same method above but using a 50cm length of cord.

Have fun using different charms and bead patterns. Wear them with your favourite outfits or share them with your friends!

### Using a Split Ring (for a necklace)

- **1.** Choose a pet charm with a ring at the top and attach a split ring onto it.
- 2. Cut 50cm of stretch cord.
- **3.** Thread a charm to the centre of the cord.
- **4.** Now thread 10-15 beads onto one side of the cord. Tie 2-3 knots afterwards.
- **5.** Repeat this on the other end with the same pattern of beads.
- **6.** Test the necklace around your neck to check the length is right.

 On one end of the cord, thread on half of the clasp, then a small clear bead. Tie a double knot after the bead. Trim of any excess cord, then pull the bead down inside the clasp.

8. Repeat this on the other side.

Hint: You may need some help to attach the clasp as it can be quite fiddly!

### Top Tip!

To make your bracelet extra secure dab a tiny dot of glue onto the knot to seal it.
