

WHO IS IT FOR?

This resource was created for any student(s) who need(s) to learn high frequency words.





WHY HEART WORDS?

Teaching heart words instead of memorization (sight words) teaches students to recognize the decodable parts of the word using phonics, requiring them to only memorize the irregular (or phonics skill not yet learned) part of the word (the "heart part").



Wait! Lauren, why are there flash cards for phonetically spelled words?



Yes, the words *like* and *play* <u>are</u> decodable.

However, when do your students learn CVCe or long vowel teams?

Chances are, it would benefit them to be able to read the words *like* and *play* <u>before</u> learning these phonics skills.

Phonetically spelled high frequency words are temporary heart words (or flash words).

Depending on your scope and sequence, some of the words may no longer be "heart words" for your students.

This is another reason why this resource is fully editable.



two types of cards

True heart words (irregular words) have the hearts and lines already added to them.



Temporary heart words (or flash words) do NOT have the hearts and lines added because the "heart part" varies according to your phonics scope and sequence. This is why the flash cards are fully editable.
