Not intended for children under 12 years of age.

Individuals with medical conditions affecting balance, swimming ability, or consciousness should consult a physician before use.

Maximum weight capacity: 200 lb (90 kg). One rider only.

- Follow all weight and use restrictions.
- For use in **calm, sheltered water only.**
- Do **not** use in areas with boat traffic, current, tides, surf, or strong wind.

- Never tow this seat behind any vehicle or watercraft.
- Do not jump onto or off of the seat.
- Do not dive from or swim underneath the seat.
- Do not leave the seat unattended in the water.
- Inspect the seat for leaks, punctures, or damage before every use. Do not use if damaged.
- Entrapment hazard: Be cautious of anchoring lines, tethers, or accessories.
- Not intended for land-based use or as furniture.
- Do not use before sunrise or after sunset.
- Do not consume alcohol or drugs while using this product.
- Deck materials may become slippery when wet. Always wear slip-resistant footwear.
- Hypothermia can occur even in warm water. Dress appropriately for conditions.
- Always check weather conditions before use. Conditions can change rapidly.
- Bring a buddy and let someone know your plans whenever recreating on or near water.

General Use Information

Your inflatable hammock seat is designed for relaxing flotation in **calm, protected water**. Always use common sense and follow all safety, care, and maintenance guidelines in this manual.

- Intended for seated lounging only

- One rider at a time
- Not intended for towing, high-energy water activity, or rough conditions

Caring for Your Inflatable Seat

We have a feeling you're going to love your new seat. There are a few things you should know about caring for your seat before taking it out. Hey, we all need some TLC.

- **Do not store the seat (inflated or deflated) in direct sunlight or excessive heat**, such as inside a closed vehicle.
- Heat increases internal air pressure and may cause permanent damage.
- If temporarily left inflated in the sun, place the seat in shade and release a small amount of air.
- Do **not** drag the seat across rough surfaces. Doing so can cause damage and voids the warranty.
- Rinse with fresh water after every use.
- Allow to dry completely before storing.
- Do not leave the seat inflated for extended periods of time.

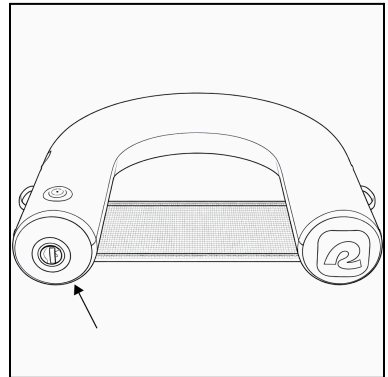
Inflation Instructions

1. Prepare the Seat:

Find a clean, flat surface free of any debris or sharp objects and unroll your seat. Locate the valve on one of the rounded "arm" ends. It looks like the same valve on any Retrospec iSUP or inflatable platform.

2. Prepare the Valve:

Remove the valve cover. Before you start to inflate, make sure the inflation valve stem is closed to keep air from escaping (in the UP position). If the inflation valve stem is down and air is escaping, press and turn the valve stem so that it pops back up.



3. Prepare your Pump (not included):

Ensure the pump hose and pressure gauge are secured onto the pump handle.

4. Secure the Hose to the Valve:

Push the hose into the air valve and twist clockwise until you feel it lock onto the valve.

5. Inflate:

Begin pumping air into the seat. Note that the pressure gauge will not register pressure right away. Once the seat reaches the desired pressure, remove the hose from the valve and replace the valve cap onto the valve body. Recommended pressure is 3-5 PSI. Check pressure before each use.

6. Transport:

Do not transport your seat fully pressurized. Traveling from low to high altitudes will increase air pressure in the chamber and can damage your seat due to over-pressurization.

7. WARNING: Do Not Exceed the Recommended Pressure!

Do not use an unregulated air compressor to fill the seat. Exceeding the recommended pressure will permanently damage the seat and voids the warranty.

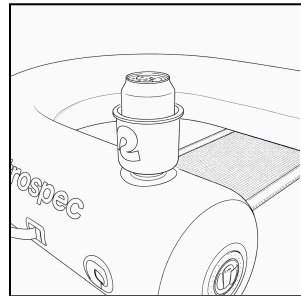
8. If the Valve Leaks:

Use the supplied air valve wrench from the repair kit to tighten the valve clockwise and stop the leak.

Features & Set up Tips

- **DrinkLink Cup Holder:** Securely holds beverages while lounging.
- Designed to be used alone or alongside compatible inflatable docks or platforms (sold separately).
- Position the seat in calm water and enter carefully from a seated or kneeling position.



Deflation and Storage

1. Clean and Dry:

With the seat inflated and the valve closed, rinse the seat with fresh water to clean it of any sand or debris. Allow it to dry completely. Do not store while still wet to prevent mildew buildup.

2. Deflate:

- a. Once the valve area is dry, remove the valve cap, keeping your face away from the valve as the air will escape rapidly at first and could cause harm.
- b. Press down lightly on the inflation valve stem to release some of the air – which will slow down after the initial strong burst.
- c. Press and turn the inflation valve stem to lock the stem in the open (DOWN) position to fully deflate the seat.
- d. Once the seat is fully deflated, press and turn the inflation valve stem to the closed (UP) position.

3. Fold:

- a. Fold the seat neatly from the end opposite the valve toward the valve.
- b. Secure with the strap and buckle.

Storage

Place your seat back into its bag and store in a safe place. Make sure it is protected from the elements, extreme heat or cold.

PLEASE NOTE: To maximize the lifespan of your seat, do not store the seat fully inflated (not even temporarily). It is important to deflate the seat after every use.

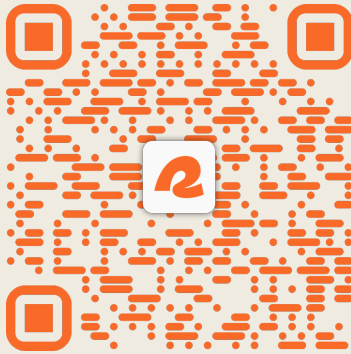
