
Taffrail Installation Instructions



- Identify if there are any hidden pipes or electrical cables in the wall to avoid causing damage or risk of electrical shock during installation. Determine the fixing method appropriate to the wall structure (e.g. plaster board plugs).
- To secure your Taffrail to the wall simply loop the leather strap supplied around the top of the bend as detailed above. Make sure the small holes in both ends of the leather strap are aligned.
- 3. The feet of the Taffrail should be flat against the floor at the angle they have been cut. You may need to adjust the angle of the Taffrail to make sure the feet are flat against the floor.
- 4. Once the Taffrail is at the correct angle, make a mark on the wall through the holes in the strap. Using the domed screw provided and fixing method appropriate to the wall structure if required, screw the leather strap to the wall.
- 5. The leather strap should not be taking the weight of the Taffrail, simply securing it in place.
