



1	SOLENOID AND CHECK VALVE ASSEMBLY
2	ELBOW ASSEMBLY
A	CHECK VALVE TO ELBOW CONNECTION (FEMALE)
В	CHECK VALVE TO ELBOW CONNECTION (MALE, TEFLON WRAPPED)
С	ELBOW TO SYSTEM CONNECTION (MALE, TEFLON WRAPPED)
D	PERMEATE FLUSH PORT

1. Installation:

- 1.1. Turn off the water supply to the system and disconnect the power.
- 1.2. Locate the permeate flush port on the system.
- 1.3. Remove the plug. Ensure there is no Teflon tape left in the port.
- 1.4. Thread connection point C on the elbow assembly into the connection point D on the system.
- 1.5. Thread connection point A on the solenoid and check valve assembly onto connection point B on the elbow assembly.







- 2. Electrical Connection:
 - 2.1. Locate the provided solenoid connection. This will be coiled behind the RO controller.
 - 2.2. Remove the DIN connector cover on the flush solenoid.
 - 2.3. Connect the DIN connector. Secure the connection by tightening the screw.
- 3. Permeate Water Connection:

3.1. Connect the pressurized permeate supply to the permeate feed (Connection E).

- 4. Changing the Flush Mode on the Controller:
 - 4.1. Re-connect the power and turn the feed water back on. Press and hold the up and down arrows to access the menu.
 - 4.2. The controller should display "RO Presets Program 4". Press the "Manual Run / Flush" key.
 - 4.3. Press and hold the up and down arrows on the controller, while holding, press the "Manual Run / Flush" key to access the controller menu. Change to "RO Presets Program 3". The flush mode has been changed. The standard flush time upon system shut down is 2 minutes.
 - 4.4. To revert to a standard feed flush. Repeat these steps and return to "RO Presets Program 4".
