LESSONS WITH AUDIO

lesson format

- 1** listen to the word in isolation & in a sentence
[audio, no text]
- 2** identify the number of sounds in the word
[audio of word available]
- 3** [blank] sound boxes appear
- 4** tap and map sounds (no text)
[audio of word available]
- 5** graph sounds and heart if applicable
[explicit instruction from teacher required here based on scope & sequence]
- 6** rewrite word from memory
- 7** read the word in a decodable sentence (x2)
- 8** prompt to audibly use the word in a decodable sentence [partner work]
- 9** prompt to write the sentence [on paper or whiteboard]



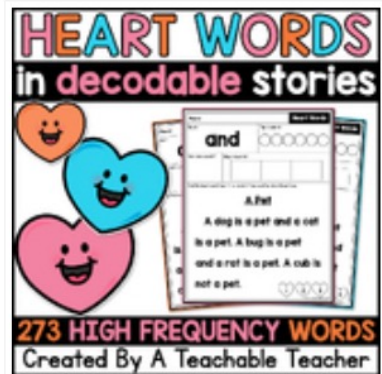
