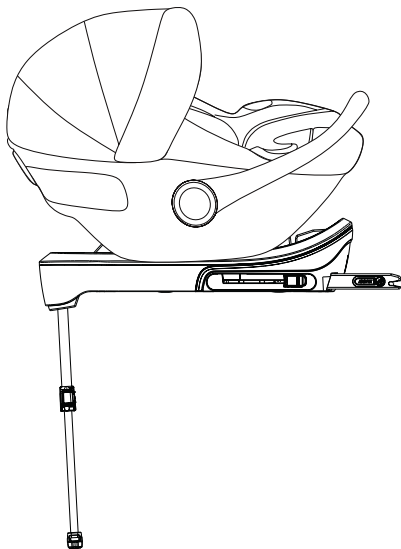

## warning

This child safety seat has passed UN Regulation No.129/03.

Please read the full instructions before assembling and using this product.

1. The rigid items and plastic parts of an Enhanced Child Restraint System (ECRS) shall be located and installed so that they are not liable, during everyday use of the vehicle, to become trapped by a movable seat or in a door of the vehicle.
2. Do not use carry-cots perpendicular to the longitudinal axis of the vehicle.
3. Any straps holding the restraint to the vehicle should be tight, any support-leg should be in contact with the vehicle floor, any straps or impact shields restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's body, and straps should not be twisted.
4. It is important to ensure that any lap strap is worn low down.
5. The Enhanced Child Restraint System should be replaced when it has been subject to violent stresses in an accident.
6. It is dangerous to make any alterations or additions to the device without the approval of the Type Approval Authority, and it is also dangerous not following closely the installation instructions provided by the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer.
7. Be sure that children are not left in their ECRS unattended.

8. Any luggage or other objects liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured.
9. The Enhanced Child Restraint System shall not be used without the cover.
10. The Enhanced Child Restraint System cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer because the cover constitutes an integral part of the restraint performance.
11. Refer to the vehicle manufacturer's handbook for the use of an "i-Size ECRS".

**NOTICE:** This is an i-Size Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UN Regulation No.129, for use in, i-Size compatible vehicle seating positions as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle users manual.

If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

Do not use the ECRS in seating positions where there is an active frontal airbag installed.

## **warranty**

All of our products have a one year warranty from date of purchase against defects in material and workmanship.\*

Additionally, when you register your product online within 30 days of purchase, you are eligible for a 2 year warranty free of charge.

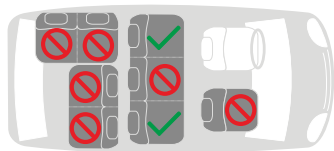
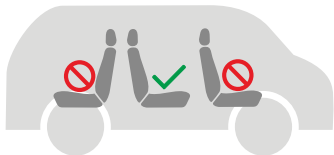
## 2. use in the vehicle

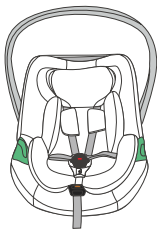


## 3. securing your baby

### 3.1 securing your baby using the newborn insert



#### for the protection of your baby



The newborn insert gives your baby the necessary support while he or she is still small. The newborn insert is used to provide extra comfort for very small babies.

**Caution!** Please use the newborn insert attached to this infant carrier when your baby's height is less than 75cm

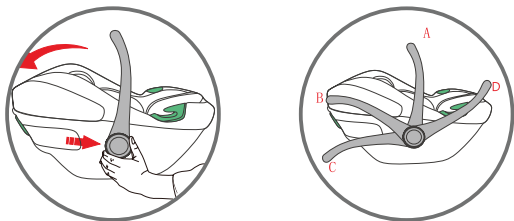
- Always secure your baby in the infant carrier using the harness.
- Never leave your baby unattended in the infant carrier when placing it on elevated surfaces (e.g. a table, nappy changing unit, etc.).
- Never allow the strap end to become caught in moving parts (e.g. automatic doors, escalators, etc.).
- Caution! The plastic parts of the infant carrier heat up in the sun,

so that your baby may get burnt. Protect your baby and the infant carrier against intensive solar radiation (e.g. by putting a light cloth over the seat).

- The infant carrier requires only one seating position in the car. This advantage means, however, that your baby must be in a semi-reclined position.
- Take your baby out of the infant carrier as often as possible to relieve its spine. We recommend frequent breaks during long journeys. Even outside of the car, please avoid leaving your baby in the infant carrier for too long.

### 3.2 adjusting the handle

You can engage the adjuster in four positions



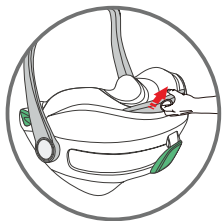
Simultaneously press both buttons on the handle. Then whilst holding the adjustor pressed turn the handle backwards until it engages in the desired position.

- A.** Only available for carrying, can not be used when installing on the vehicle seat. Caution! Ensure that the handle is securely engaged before you pick up the infant carrier.
- B.** For placing your baby into the infant carrier. Tip! You can move the handle from one position to another by pushing a button.
- C.** For setting the infant carrier down safely outside the car.
- D.** For use when installing on the vehicle seat.

### **3.3 adjusting the headrest**

**A correctly adjusted headrest ensures your baby's optimal posture in the infant carrier.**

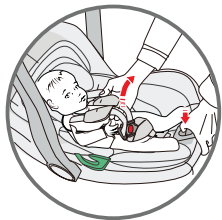
The headrest must be adjusted so that the shoulder straps are at the same level as your baby's shoulders or slightly above.



**To adjust the height of the headrest to fit your baby:**

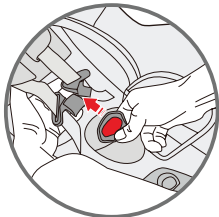
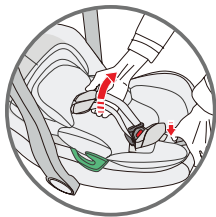

**3.4 loosening the shoulder straps**

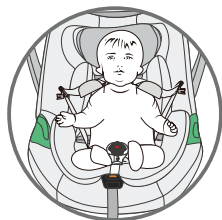


Press the harness release button and at the same time pull both shoulder straps forward.

### 3.5 securing your baby using the harness



- Loosen the shoulder straps.
- Open the harness buckle (press the red release button).



- Place your baby into the infant carrier.
- Put the shoulder straps over the shoulders of your baby, then put the buckle tongues together and engage in the harness buckle with an audible "click".

**Caution!** Do not twist or interchange the shoulder straps.

### 3.6 tightening the harness



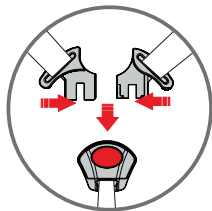
Pull the strap end

### 3.7 checklist to ensure that your baby is buckled up correctly



**For the safety of your baby, please check that...**



- The shoulder straps of the infant carrier are comfortable but **FIRM** fit around your child.
- The shoulder straps are adjusted correctly.
- The shoulder straps are not twisted.
- The buckle tongues are engaged in the harness buckle.

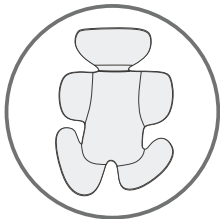

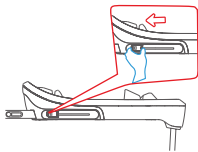
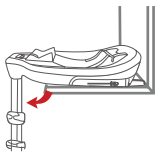

## 4.1 installation instructions for stature 40-87cm, rearward facing, ISOFIX + support leg + harness

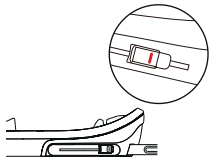
### Method 1

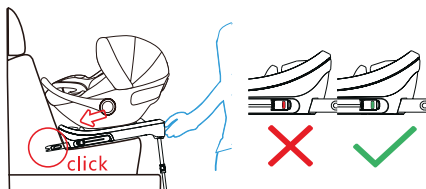
First install the base on the seat, then put the infant carrier into the base.



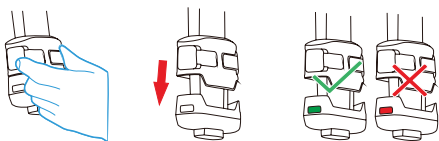
Unfold support leg until it locks in place. Press the ISOFIX release button to slide the ISOFIX connectors to the end.

**Caution:** Please only move to next step when ISOFIX has been slid to the end and the red marks have appeared.





Push the ISOFIX connectors directly into the anchorages until you hear an audible "click" sound. Grasp the seat base to check if the seat is fastened tightly or shakes, meanwhile observe the ISOFIX red/green indicator. If the seat shakes and the ISOFIX connectors are pulled out, please repeat the above steps and install it again.



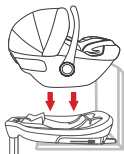
Squeeze the support leg adjusting button, pull out the support leg until it rests firmly on the floor. Observe the ISOFIX red/green indicator to confirm the installation status.



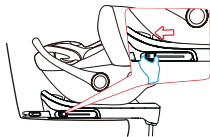
Match the infant carrier with the base, press down on the front and back until there are two "click" sounds. Make sure it is connected correctly by gently shaking and lifting the infant carrier. Ensure that the handle is in its upper position D.

## Method 2

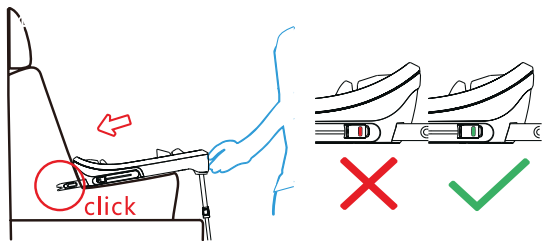
First install infant carrier into the base, and then install both on the seat.



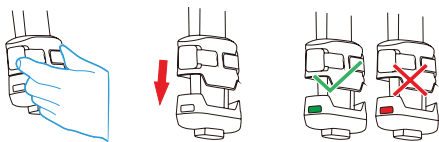
Put the infant carrier into the base.



Unfold support leg until it locks in place. Press the ISOFIX release button to slide the ISOFIX connectors to the end.



Push the ISOFIX connectors directly into the anchorages until you hear an audible "click" sound. Grasp the seat base to check if the seat is fastened tightly or shakes, meanwhile observe the ISOFIX red/green indicator. If the seat shakes and the ISOFIX connectors are pulled out, please repeat the above steps and install it again.

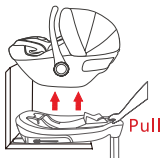

## 5. removing from the vehicle

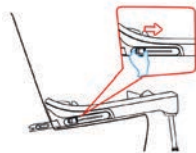
### Method 1

First remove the infant carrier from the base, then remove the base.

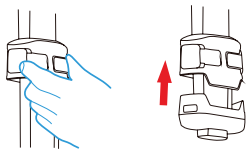


Pull the handle on the base to unlock.

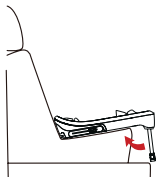
Remove the infant carrier from the base.



Press the ISOFIX release button to slide the ISOFIX connectors to separate the base and the seat.



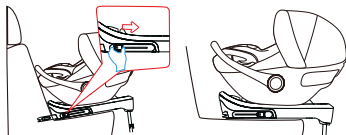
Squeeze the support leg adjusting button to retract the support leg.



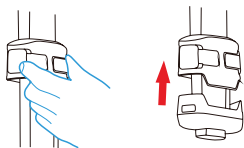
Finally, rotate the support leg and insert it into the slot at the bottom of the seat.

## Method 2

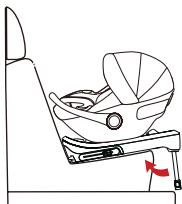
First remove the infant carrier and the base from the seat together.



Press the ISOFIX release button to slide the ISOFIX connectors to separate the base and the seat.

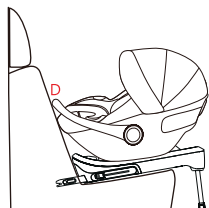


Squeeze the support leg adjusting button to retract the support leg.



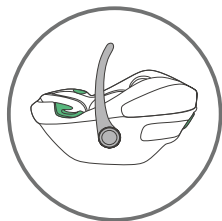
Finally, rotate the support leg and insert it into the slot at the bottom of the seat

## 6. fitting the sunhood

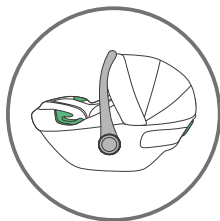


Ensure that the handle is in its upper position D.

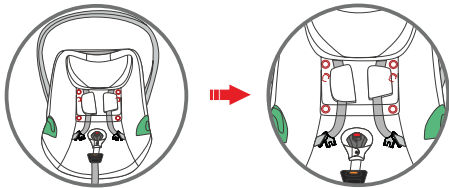
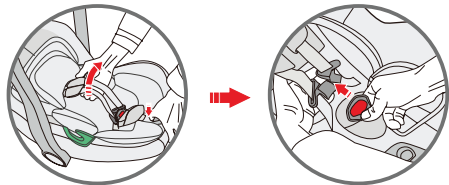
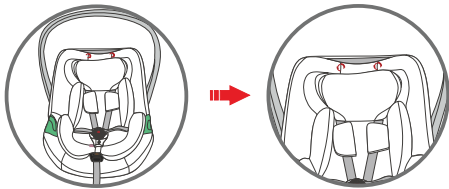
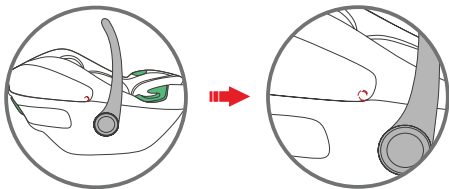
### To retain the protective effect

- In an accident at a collision speed above 10 km/h the child safety seat could suffer damage which is not necessarily obvious.
- In such cases it is extremely important that you replace the child seat. Please dispose of it properly.
- Regularly check all important parts for damage.
- Ensure the correct operation of all mechanical components.
- To prevent damage or breakage, ensure that the child seat does not become jammed in the car door, seat runners, etc.
- Should the child seat be damaged (for example after dropping it) it must be inspected by the manufacturer.

### 8.1 care for the harness buckle

The function of the harness buckle is important for the safety of your child. Malfunctions of the harness buckle are mostly attributable to accumulation of dirt and dust.

## 8.2 method of cleaning fabric cover



1. Undo the snaps on the side part of the cover.
2. Undo the snaps on the main cover.
3. Press the harness release button and at the same time pull both shoulder straps forward.
4. Undo the snaps on the main cover and remove the shoulder pads.
5. Take off the fabric cover and wash it.

### 8.3 refitting the cover

To refit the cover on the seat please follow the above steps in reverse.

### 8.4 cleaning

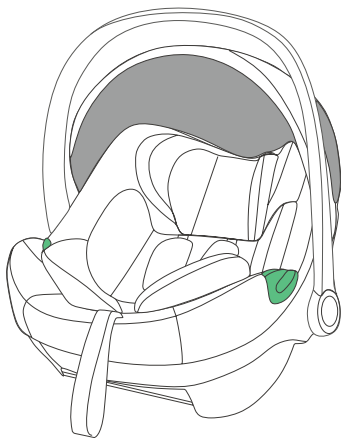
Please be sure to use only original replacement seat covers, as the seat cover is important to the proper functioning of the system. Replacement seat covers are available from your retailer.



**The child seat must not be used without the seat cover.**

- The **cover** can be removed and washed with a mild detergent using the delicate cycle on the washing machine (30°C). Please observe the instructions on the washing label of the cover. The colours of the cover may fade if washed at more than 30°C. Do not spin, wring or iron and never tumble dry in an clothes dryer (the fabric may separate from the padding).
- The **plastic parts** can be cleaned using soapy water. **Do not** use harsh cleaning agents (such as solvents).
- The harness can be removed and washed in lukewarm soapy water.

**Caution!** Never remove the buckle tongues from the straps.



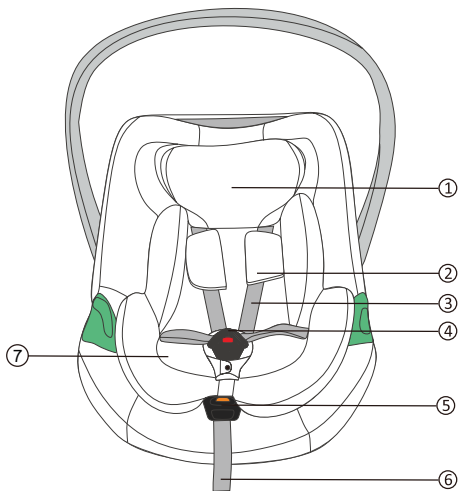

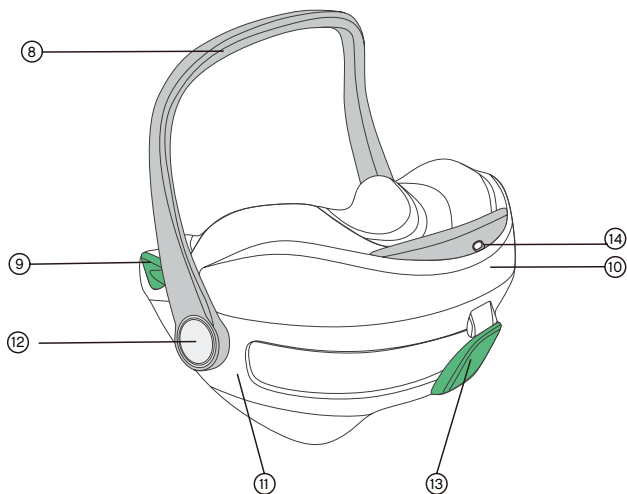

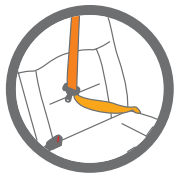


## 1. use in the vehicle



**DO NOT use on a passenger seat with a front airbag!**

**Danger!** An airbag hitting the infant carrier can cause serious injuries to your child, possibly resulting in death. Please observe the instructions in your vehicle manual for the use of child seats.



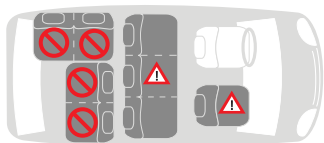
**DO NOT use with 2-point belt.**

**Use only with the vehicle's 3 point seatbel**

Please observe the regulations applicable to your particular country. Do not use with 2-point belt. The safety belt must be approved to ECE R 16 or a comparable standard.

Do not use on passenger seats with a front airbag! Can be used if the vehicle seat is equipped with a 3-point belt.

## with the vehicle's 3-point seatbelt



### You can use your child car seat as follows:

in the direction of travel	no
against the direction of travel	yes
with 2-point belt	no 1)
with 3-point belt	yes 2)
on front passenger seat	yes 3)
on outer rear seat	yes

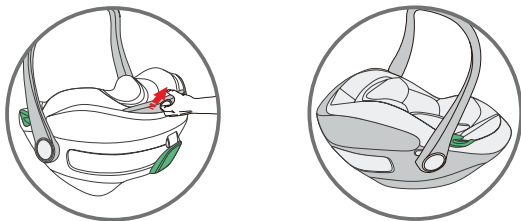
(Please observe the regulations applicable to your particular country).

- 1) The use of a 2-point belt substantially increases the risk of injury to your child in the event of an accident.
- 2) The safety belt must be approved to ECR R 16 or a comparable standard (see test label on belt with an "E" or "e" in a circle).
- 3) Do not use on passenger seats with front airbag!
- 4) Can be used if the vehicle seat is equipped with a 3-point belt.

## 2. adjusting the headrest

**A correctly adjusted headrest ensures your baby's optimal posture in the infant carrier.**

The headrest must be adjusted so that the shoulder straps are at the same level as your baby's shoulders or slightly above.

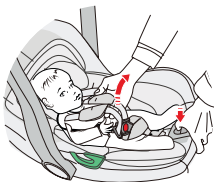

## 8. securing the infant carrier in your vehicle

To secure the infant carrier using the 3-point belt of your vehicle proceed as follows:



Place the infant carrier rearward-facing on the vehicle seat (baby is facing backwards).

**TIP!** In certain cases it is possible that the infant carrier does not rest securely or is inclined too steeply on the vehicle seat.

- Ensure that the handle is in its upper position D.  
Pull out the vehicle seat belt and place it across the infant carrier.
- Engage the buckle tongue in the vehicle seat buckle.
- Place the lap belt section in the green belt guides on both sides of the infant carrier.



**Caution!** Do not twist the belt.

Tighten the lap belt section by pulling the diagonal belt section. Pull the diagonal seat belt section behind the top end of the infant carrier.

## 9. checklist for the correct installation of the infant carrier in your car



**For the safety of your baby, please check that...**

- The infant carrier is installed rearward-facing.
- The infant carrier is only installed on the front passenger seat if no front airbag can strike the infant carrier.
- The infant carrier is only secured using 3-point belt.
- The lap belt section runs through both green belt guides on the infant carrier.
- The diagonal belt section runs through the light green belt guides on the infant carrier.
- The vehicle belt is tightened up and not twisted.
