





Assembly:




Holding it upside down, slide the 3 Clear Hoppers (C) onto the Center Support (B).


> Make sure the edges of the hoppers are slid into the grooves of the Center Support.




Line up the Bottom (D) of the Bird Feeder, and press each of the Target Latches out of the way to push the Bottom (D) securely onto the Hoppers (C).



1. Insert the Lock Pin (E) into the Bottom (D) of the Bird Feeder and 2. Twist to lock into place.



Press the Branch (F) securely onto the Bird Feeder Stand.



Hang the assembled Bird Feeder on the Branch of the Feeder Stand.


Check the side of the box for repacking instructions!

SET UP:

Pick a spot to set up the game with enough space for all players to stand and move around comfortably, with the fully assembled Bird Feeder at the center of the table.

Make sure all three doors on the bottom of the Bird Feeder are closed. Then, fill each Clear Hopper with Acorns and Peanuts. We recommend distributing the Nuts somewhat evenly between the three Hoppers.

Give each player a Nest Bowl to set on the table and an even number of Squirrels (six for 2 Players, four for 3 Players).



PLAY:

All players should take a big step back from the table before beginning. On the count of three, all players begin flinging their Squirrels at the Bird Feeder, aiming for the three Targets. Keep shooting at the Bird Feeder until a Hopper releases. Sometimes the Squirrels might struggle to break into the feeder. Another crack at it should pop the Feeder open and spill the Nuts.

Note: You do not need to keep using the same colour squirrels you began the game with—grab whichever Squirrels are nearest to you to keep shooting!

Once a target is hit, the door for that Hopper will open and spill Nuts out onto the table. All players then race to grab as many Nuts as they can to squirrel away in their Nests.


Once all the nuts are collected from that release, pause and take a moment to redistribute the Squirrels and take a step back from the table again. Then it's back to everyone shooting at the same time, now aiming for the targets that have not been hit yet. Repeat the process of shooting at the Feeder and collecting Nuts until all three Hoppers have been emptied.

Tally up your Nuts to determine who won! Peanuts are worth 1 point each, and Acorns are worth 3 points each. The nuttiest Squirrel is the winner!

Close up the Bird Feeder doors, refill the Hoppers, and play again!



Squirrel Shooting Instructions:



3. Aim and release the tail to shoot the target.

Feel free to practice shooting the Squirrels at the Bird Feeder while it is empty to practice your shootin' skills before you play.

Looking for a challenge?

Once you've mastered the game, try playing further away from the table. For games with a mix of older and younger players, consider having the younger players stand one step away from the table, and older players stand two steps away to even out the difficulty.

NOTE: If your squirrels get a little dirty, wash them with soap and warm water and allow them to dry before playing.
