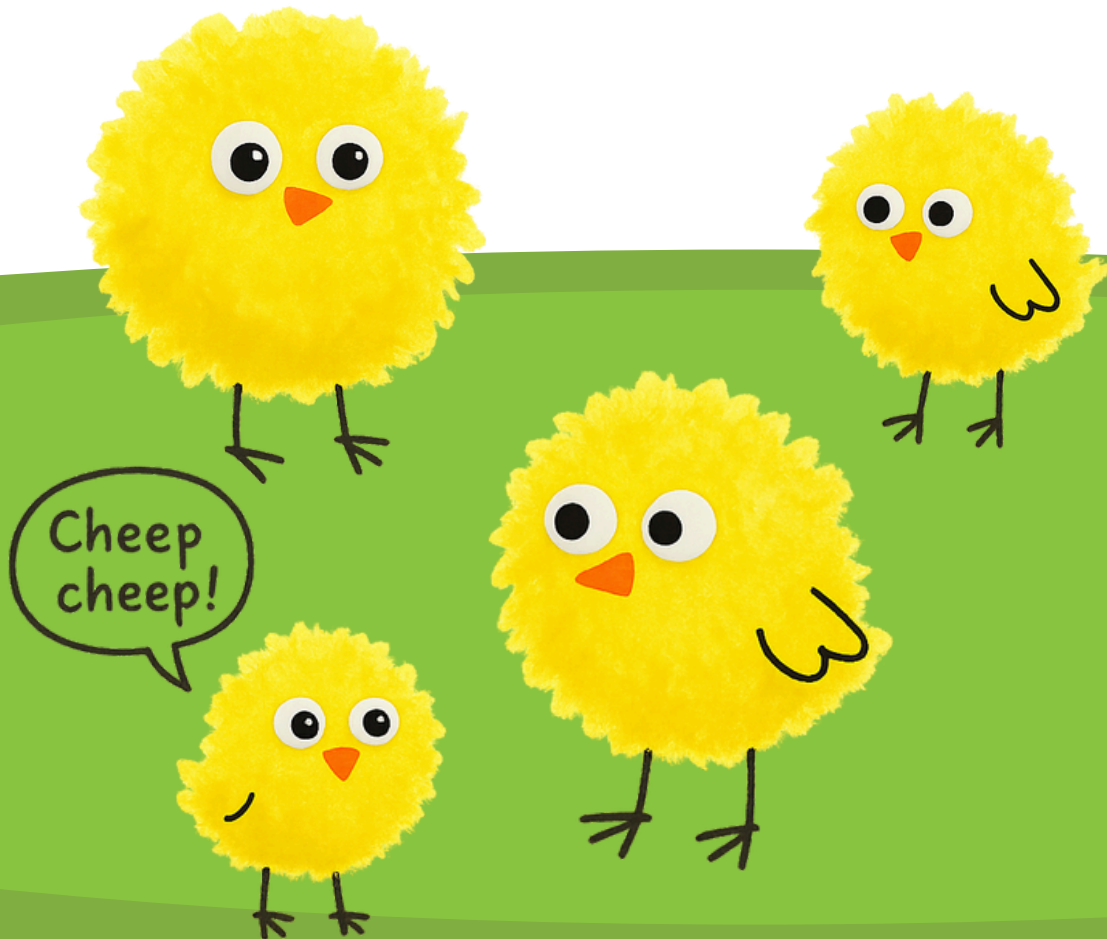

Pom-Pom Chick Stamping

Suitable For 3+ Years



Let's

Create adorable, fluffy little chicks using pom-poms and paint! This hands-on craft is perfect for little ones to explore textures, colours, and springtime fun.

You will need:

- Yellow pom-poms (small to medium size)
- Yellow paint
- White paper or card
- Googly eyes
- Orange paper (for beaks and feet)
- Glue
- Black felt tip or crayon
- Paper plate or paint tray

Let's get started!

1. Dip & Dab

Pour a little yellow paint onto a plate. Take a pom-pom and dip it into the paint. Stamp it gently onto the paper to make fluffy chick shapes. Repeat to make as many chicks as you like!

2. Add Googly Eyes

Once the paint is dry, stick on googly eyes to bring your chick to life. Use two per chick, or mix it up with one giant eye for some silliness!

3. Cut & Stick

Cut out small triangle beaks and little chick feet from orange paper. Glue them onto each pom-pom print. You could also draw them on if you prefer.

4. Draw the Details

Use a black felt tip or crayon to add legs, wings, or even little speech bubbles. ("Cheep cheep!" is always a winner.)

5. Show Off Your Spring Flock!

Hang your chick masterpiece on the fridge or pin it up to create a sunny Easter display.
