



CARE & MAINTENANCE

To keep a rug looking its best, vacuum it frequently without rotating brushes and avoid direct sunlight to prevent fading. Rotate the rug occasionally for even wear and check the care label for specific instructions.

We always recommend professional cleaning for all our rugs. Materials like jute, unbleached linen, and viscose are very sensitive and can be damaged by spot cleaning. Please note that all stain removal is at your own risk and not always possible. If you still wish to try removing stains yourself, here are some tips.

Act quickly

Treat stains before they dry. Always use clean, white cloths. Some materials like jute, unbleached linen, and viscose can be damaged by water.

Colored liquids (coffee, red wine, juice)

Quickly cover the stain with salt, let dry, then vacuum. If the stain remains, dab it with sparkling water. Always blot, do not rub.

• Greasy substances (lipstick, shoe polish, cream, oil)

Scrape off as much as possible right away. Then use a carpet shampoo. Test on a hidden spot first.

Marker or ink

Dab with household alcohol (test first), then blot with water. Absorb moisture with paper towels or a clean cloth. Repeat if necessary.

Wax

Place four layers of paper towel over the wax and iron with medium heat to melt and absorb it. Repeat as needed.
