Since our establishment in 1980, Linie Design has been committed to exclusively producing handmade rugs. Every rug is crafted with care and skill by Indian weavers using traditional techniques passed down through generations. Each weaver has a unique style developed over years of practice, giving each rug a distinct personality. The slight variations create life, authenticity, and visual interest. No machine can replicate the meticulous skill of weaver's hands.

Time-honoured process

It takes weeks or months to weave a handmade rug depending on the technique and size. Large rugs can require multiple weavers working simultaneously.

Masterful skills

Hand-knotted rugs are the most intricate, with experienced weavers tying 8.000-10.000 knots per day.

• Attention to detail

Once removed from the loom, rugs are carefully checked before they are finished. Some rug types require more attention than others. For example pile rugs have to be sheared by hand to achieve high-low contrasts, defined textures, and smooth finishes.
