



UNDERLAY FOR RUGS

The right underlay can make a big difference in both comfort and function. We offer two different sizes of underlays: a thin and a thick version, so the rug does not slip.

• Thin underlays are best for

Rugs that are already thick or heavy Situations where a lower-cost solution is needed Under dining tables, where a firmer surface is preferred

• Thick underlays are best for

Thin or lightweight rugs that might slip Uneven floors When comfort and insulation are important (both sound and heat) High-quality or luxury rugs

How to install a large rug underlay

- 1. Clean and make sure the floor is dry
- 2. Place the rug where you want it and fold it in half
- 3. Fold the underlay and place it under the empty space
- 4. Flip the folded half of the rug back over the underlay
- 5. Repeat on the other side
- 6. Smooth out wrinkles by hand, working in small sections

Tip: Underlays are easy to cut with scissors. Cut them so they are 5 cm smaller than the rug on all sides.
